Types of Institutions

The UK is home to some of the oldest and most prestigious universities in the world. Prestigious research universities such as Oxford, Cambridge, and Imperial College London, and other government-funded institutions offer high-quality education.

Types of Programmes

UK universities offer an extensive selection of foundation, undergraduate, and postgraduate programmes in various disciplines.

- **Foundation Programmes:** One-year preparatory courses for international students who need to meet entry requirements for undergraduate degrees
- **Undergraduate Programmes:** Typically three years (four in Scotland), with options for sandwich courses that include a year in industry to gain corporate experience
- **Postgraduate Programmes:** Master's programmes usually last one to two years, while PhDs take three to four years with research-intensive training



Intakes and Deadlines

The main intake for UK universities with the widest range of courses is in September (Autumn/Fall). The January (Winter) and May (Summer) intakes offer limited courses but less competition for university and admissions, along with the opportunity to pursue specialised postgraduate courses.

Work-Integrated Learning and Internships

Many universities offer placement years, internships, and industry partnerships to help students gain practical experience. Sandwich courses in particular can help students get access to relevant job opportunities, allowing them to gain related professional experience over the course of their studies.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

The UK government, universities, external institutions, and private benefactors offer many scholarships each year to support international students pursuing education in the UK. Some scholarships offer deductions on tuition fees while others offer additional funding towards the cost of living, travel, and other essential costs students may have to bear during their time in the UK.

Working While Studying

International students on a Student Visa in the UK can work up to 20 hours per week during term time and full-time during holidays.

Ireland's higher education system is known for its high academic standards with state-of-the-art laboratories, well-resourced libraries, and research-driven campuses that provide an excellent student experience.

National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ)


The NFQ provides guidance for students, employers, and education providers to understand and compare qualifications offered by Irish universities. It is also aligned with the European Qualification Framework (EQF) and the Qualifications Framework of the European Higher Education Area (QF-EHEA), making it easier to compare qualifications across Europe.

Types of Institutions

Ireland is home to research-driven institutions offering undergraduate, postgraduate, and PhD programmes and Institutes of Technology focusing on applied sciences, engineering, and business. Other colleges and private higher education institutions offer specialised diploma and degree programmes in areas like vocational training, medicine, law, business studies, and agriculture.

Credit System and Semester Schedules

Most universities in Ireland follow the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), allowing students to have their academic qualifications and study periods recognised internationally.



Intakes and Deadlines

The main intake with the widest range of courses for Irish universities is in September (Autumn). The January (Spring) intake offers fewer course options for select programmes.

Research and Postgraduate Opportunities

The Department of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science offers programmes to fund research in various disciplines. For example, the Government of Ireland Postgraduate Scholarship Programme funds research in technology, pharmaceuticals, renewable energy, and data science.

Scholarships and Financial Support

The Government of Ireland, universities, and other institutions offer a range of scholarships, tuition fee waivers, and discounts for international students, based on merit and need.

Working While Studying

International students on a Stamp 2 student visa in Ireland can work up to 20 hours per week during term time and up to 40 hours per week during holidays.

UK and Ireland Visa System

Both the UK and Ireland have structured visa processes, work rights, and post-study opportunities for international students. Understanding each aspect can make planning your studies in the UK or Ireland much easier.

UK

International students planning to study in the UK must apply for a **Student Visa**.

Application Process

- Apply to the chosen university, receive an offer, and **acquire the Certificate of Acceptance of Studies (CAS letter)**
- **Apply for visa online through the UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) portal** and pay the application fee (£490)
- **Provide financial proof** for tuition and living expenses (£1,023 per month outside London, £1,334 in London)
- **Pay the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS)** to access NHS healthcare during studies (£776 per year)
- **Attend a biometric appointment and visa interview** (if required) at a UK Visa Application Centre

Visa Extensions

Students can extend their visa to stay longer and continue their course or study a new course. The application must be sent in before the current visa expires, and students are allowed to stay in the UK until they receive a decision.

Dependent Visas

Dependent visas are available for a student's husband, wife, civil partner, unmarried partner, or child under 18 years old. This is only available to students enrolled in a PhD or other doctorate (RQF level 8), or a research-based higher degree.

Post-Study Work Opportunities and Permanent Residency Pathway

The Graduate Route allows international graduates to stay in the UK for two years after completing a bachelor's or master's degree and three years after completing a PhD. No job sponsorship is required to stay and work under this route and graduates can switch to a Skilled Worker Visa if they receive a job offer from an approved UK employer.

Graduates on the Skilled Worker Visa may be eligible to apply for Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) after five years. ILR also allows graduates to apply for British citizenship.

Ireland

Non-EU/EEA students must apply for a **Study Visa** to study in Ireland. The visa process is managed through the Automated Visa Application and Tracking System under the Irish Immigration Service Delivery (ISD).

Application Process

- Apply **online through the AVATS Online Application facility**
- **Receive an offer letter** from an Irish university or college
- **Provide financial proof** of at least €7,000 for courses requiring residence over eight months
- Show **health insurance coverage** for the duration of studies
- **Attend a biometric appointment** (if required) and submit supporting documents

Visa Extensions

Students can get extensions to their Study Visa if they are enrolled in a full-time study or higher education course that is recognised on the Interim List of Eligible Programmes (ILEP). Students can apply for renewal up to 12 weeks before the expiry of the current visa to allow time for processing.

Dependent Visas

Dependent visas are not available for undergraduate students in Ireland, but they may be granted to spouses and children of postgraduate students under certain conditions.

Post-Study Work Opportunities and Permanent Residency Pathway

The Third Level Graduate Scheme allows students to stay and work in Ireland for up to two years after graduation.

Graduates with job offers in high-demand sectors can also apply for a Critical Skills Employment Permit, which allows them to apply for a Stamp 4 permission to live and work in Ireland without an employment permit after 21 months. After five years of legal residence, individuals with Stamp 4 may qualify for Irish citizenship through naturalisation.

- Financial proof for visa application
- Resume
- Standardised Test Scores (GRE/GMAT)
- Research proposal (for PhD applicants)
