Post-Study Work Visa

The Graduate Route (Post-Study Work Visa) allows international graduates to stay and work in the UK for up to two years (three years for PhD graduates) after completing their degree. Many students use this period to secure skilled worker visas and build their careers in the UK.

- Unlimited hours during holidays

Many students take up part-time jobs in retail, hospitality, administration, or paid internships, gaining valuable work experience while managing living costs.

Post-Study Work Visa

The Temporary Graduate Visa (subclass 485) allows international graduates to stay in Australia and work for up to three years, depending on their qualification level and location of study.

Australia also offers pathways for skilled migration, allowing graduates in high-demand industries to transition into permanent residency through a general skilled visa, such as Skilled Independent Visa, Skilled Nominated Visa, or Skilled Work Regional Visa.





- Full-time during holidays
- Off-campus work is only available through the CPT or OPT programmes

Many students find work in research assistantships, tutoring, university departments, or campus facilities, helping them gain valuable skills, knowledge, and experience while managing living costs.

Post-Study Work Visa

Document Preparation Checklist

Preparing the right documents is vital to ensure your study abroad application goes smoothly. You can use the following checklist to organise your documents and avoid delays.

For All Applicants

High School Transcript: Both original and translated copies (if required)

High School Graduation Certificate/Predicted Grades Sheet: Both original and translated copies (if required)

English Proficiency Certificate: Accepted tests include IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, Duolingo, or equivalent

Personal Statement: Also known as a statement of purpose (SOP) or motivation letter, explaining your academic goals and why you want to study abroad

One or More Academic Reference Letters: Letters from teachers or professors supporting your application

Additional Documents Based on Destination and Level of Study

Proof of Financial Support: Includes bank statements, sponsor letters, or scholarship award letters, required for visa applications
CV/Resume: Typically needed for postgraduate applications or if you have relevant work experience
Portfolio: Required for creative courses such as architecture, design, fine arts, or media studies
 Standardised Test Scores: Depending on the country and course, you may need: O SAT/ACT for US undergraduate applications O GRE/GMAT for postgraduate business and engineering programmes
Medical Examination and Health Insurance: Mandatory for some countries, such as Australia, Canada, and the US
Research Proposal: Required for PhD and some master's, outlining your research objectives


